

SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HAMPDEN REQUEST FOR RESPONSE 350 ELEVATOR MAINTENANCE

Sealed bids for Elevator Maintenance are to be delivered to the Sheriff's Department Hampden Jail and House of Corrections, 627 Road, Ludlow, MA 01056, and will be received until **Wednesday, March 28, 2018** at 2:00 PM at the Sheriff's Department Hampden Purchasing Department, Room 252, 627 Randall Road, Ludlow, MA 01056, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. For specifications call 413-858-0119. **All bids submitted must be clearly marked in the lower left hand corner of envelope, "RFR Number 350, Elevator Maintenance, Deadline: March 28, 2018, 2:00 PM"**.

A mandatory site visit at the Sheriff's Department Hampden, 627 Randall Road, Ludlow, MA 01056 is scheduled for **Wednesday, March 14, 2018** at 10:00 AM. Bidders must confirm attendance no later than **Monday, March 12, 2018** at 2:00 PM by contacting Ann Speziali at 413-858-0119 and supplying name of company and persons attending. Name, date of birth, and social security number must be supplied for each individual planning to attend. Sheriff's Department personnel require this information to perform a security clearance. Anyone found to be a security risk would not be allowed entrance. Individuals will be required to present a valid form of identification upon arrival on **Wednesday, March 14, 2018**.

Prevailing wage rates as set by the Massachusetts Division of Occupational Safety are applicable to this project under M.G.L. Chapter 149, Section 27H.

Bidders should also include in their submission all additional forms that the vendor is directed to submit by the attachment "Sheriff's Department Hampden Instructions to Bidders" found in the specification package.

Bidding procedures and award of contracts will be in accordance with Chapter 7 Section 22, of the Massachusetts General Laws, plus all applicable Federal, State, and local laws and regulations.

The Sheriff reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids in total or in part as he deems to be in the best interest of the Sheriff's Department Hampden and certifies under the penalties of perjury that this notice has been posted and advertised (if required) in accordance with the general laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in so far as the Sheriff has instructed the purchasing agent to make such postings and advertisements.
