Bidders must confirm attendance no later than **Tuesday, May 1, 2018** at 4:00 PM by contacting Ann Speziali at 413-858-0119 and supplying name of company and persons attending. Name, date of birth, and social security number must be supplied for each individual planning to attend. Sheriff's Department personnel require this information to perform a security clearance. Anyone found to be a security risk would not be allowed entrance. Individuals will be required to present a valid form of identification upon arrival on **Thursday, May 3, 2018**.
