The Hampden County Sheriff's Department was awarded a contract by the Office of Community Corrections ( OCC ) to provide group facilitation targeted to reduce criminogenic risks and needs. Staff is trained to deliver manualized Cognitive Behavioral Therapy. This position is primarily group facilitation with a secondary emphasis on assessments and treatment plans. All program services adhere to the principles for evidence-based practices (EBP), incorporate trauma informed approaches and utilize manualized cognitive behavioral treatment with fidelity.



**Qualifications:** Bachelor's degree in clinical psychology, education, counseling, psychology, rehabilitative counseling, social work from an accredited college or university and a minimum of two years supervised counseling or four years' experience delivering cognitive behavioral treatment to the criminal justice population or equivalent combination of education and experience.
