Individuals with lived experience are encouraged to apply.

Qualifications:

- **Must possess a Bachelor's Degree. A degree in Human Services or related field is preferred. Three years of experience in human services or substance use prevention is preferred.**
- **Must support all pathways to recovery including medication for opioid use disorder (MOUD) and harm reduction.**
- **At least two years' experience working directly with community coalitions.**
- **Must have knowledge of evidence based strategies and best practices to address substance use disorder.**
